4	<p>Matters arising:</p> <p>Joint meeting in Baildon – attended by RD, CM and DS. 5	<p>Correspondence – re. events:</p> <p>Ruth Leman – Bingley Fred Hoyle Centenary Project – asks if we can design a walk based on his life in Bingley. MC to send autobiography to RC to look at this. This could be lead around Bingley Show or the Lecture at Bingley Grammar School, which could then become a permanent walk on the website.</p>	MC, RC
6	<p>Update on sponsorship/funding:</p> <p>Skipton Grassroots Scheme:</p> <p>RD, CM and SD filled in the application and this has been sent off. RD suggested the £500 could be spent on a walk that links Bingley to Skipton. Applications close on 31st July.</p>	
7	<p>Walks:</p> <p>Prince of Wales Park Walk - 4 people attended.</p> <p>June 7th walk – no attendance - bad weather.</p> <p>Moonlight Walk at Cottingley – no volunteers.</p> <p>Damart Walk – DS is still planning this.</p> <p>CM suggested a walk with the Bingley Camera Club. Also a “1st birthday” celebration next year.</p> <p>Baildon Walking Weekend – We could look at organising an event similar to this after the summer break.</p>

9	<p>Website:</p> <p>CF – Website is built and live. Next step is to put the walks onto the page. CM asked if there was a disclaimer added to the website – CF will add this. Also – CF to add logos for Bingley Civic Trust – Bingley Crest. (RD will have this). There are 3 possible e-mail addresses and one for general initial enquiries has already been created – info@bingleywalkersarewelcome.org.uk</p> <p>SD to reimburse CF for the cost of the host site and domain for two year.</p> <p>CF - do we need to have other social media, e.g. Twitter – CF can do this so it was agreed to go ahead. 10	<p>Any other business:</p> <p>MC reported back about the proposed “Medieval Weekend” in Bingley. This is now moving towards a “Harvest Festival” theme in September or October 2015, with stalls, beer tent etc. on the Old Main Street. The church will also be involved. It is suggested we could organise a walk to coincide with this as more details emerge.</p> <p>CF - “Walk/Cycle/Ride Festival” (Hebden Bridge) – will promote walks around the area and could promote the September walk.</p>
