4	<p>Matters arising:</p> <p>1. Proposed car parking charges at St. Ives: SH – letter received from BDMC – order has been sealed and will be effective from 20/8/18. St. Ives car parking proposal have been deferred to a later date, but objections were not upheld. There was an error in sending this out as it broke GDPR rules.</p> <p>2. AGM – all went well.</p>	
5	<p>Treasurer's Report:</p> <p>At the moment the account is in a healthy state.</p> <p>£168.00 – donations from Walking Festival.</p> <p>£275.50 – sales of 166 Fred Hoyle booklets at £1.00 (shops – mark up 50p) and 73 at £1.50 (individuals)</p> <p>£64.00 - sales of 28 Bingley Loops at £1.00 (shops – mark up) and 24 at £1.50 (individuals).</p> <p>RC has sold an undisclosed number at her walking group - amount to be confirmed.</p> <p>We still owe a small amount for Welcome Way Booklets.</p>	

	<p>PAID – printing and design of the Walking Festival leaflets and posters, Hiring of Cardigan House for the AGM.</p> <p>CM will speak to SD regarding ordering a “Pop-Up Display” and getting a display table for our stall. MC will ask at BGS to see if there is a spare table they could donate. Also, more stickers to be ordered.</p>	CM/SD/MC
6	<p>Correspondence:</p> <p>CM - No correspondence since the last meeting.</p>	
7	<p>Events:</p> <p>WaW Northern Area Get Together:</p> <p>CM: UPDATED: Provisionally booked at Bingley Arts Centre for Saturday 11th May 2019. Cost for hire of entrance hall (for registration), theatre with seats pulled back for tables around the edge and to serve lunch, and with use of screen on stage) and kitchen is £300.00. There is an exhibition in the Arts Centre at the same time by Bingley Camera Club which will be a good attraction for our visitors.</p> <p>Stalls can be set up in the lounge for all individual towns, who can be invited to take one if they wish. These could also be offered to Bingley History Society and other local groups, depending on space.</p> <p>It was discussed that we could have speaker/presentation in the morning, perhaps by the Canal and River Trust (CM to make contact with Paul House after he returns from holiday on 3/9/18), and some workshops. In the afternoon, a walk could be scheduled (or an alternative for delegates as an option). The event will open at 10.00am with tea/coffee/biscuits supplied and then programme starts at 10.30am. The event will end around 4.00pm with tea/coffee/cake. CM to ask Margaret Wilcox if she can supply tea/coffee. It was proposed that we ask local supermarkets if they will donate biscuits/cakes for the event. All agreed.</p> <p>CM to contact the national committee to ask if they would like to address delegates and Ann Sandell/Randall regarding expected numbers and expected cost of lunch for delegates.</p> <p>Lunch: AB previously suggested that we invite all cafes in the Bingley area and Margaret Wilcox (supplier to BAC) to tender for providing lunch in the form of a buffet. All in favour. MC and CM to draft a letter of invite and send to all businesses. 10	<p>Walking Festival 7th May 2018: CM: The 2nd Bingley Walking Festival was again a great success. It was proposed and agreed that next year's event will take place on Monday 6th May 2018 and that we purchase an advertising banner for the railing at the prominent position opposite Park Road.</p>	
11	<p>Website: CF: Website has been updated several times since the last meeting.</p>	
12	<p>Any Other Business: Plastic Free Bingley have made us aware of a scheme in place in some areas where shops and businesses allow people to fill their water bottles for free. It was proposed and agreed that the committee look into this further and report back. UPDATED: MC has found the scheme – an app named "REFILL" where business can add themselves on to a map which shows where they are if they offer free water refills. 2 businesses in Bingley are signed up, but anyone can add them on with a photo. A representative from "Plastic-Free Bingley" has been in touch and will go around outlets asking if they will put a sticker in their windows to alert walkers to the service.</p>	Committee
