Bingley WALKING FESTIVAL The walks

1 Bingley Five Rise Locks Family Walk led by Cedric Farineau:

This 2 hours circular walk should keep everyone in the family happy as there are so many things to see and do along the way; like feed the ducks, explore the locks and watch the wildlife.

Meet Cedric at 10am outside The Coffee Lounge in Market Square.

2 Canal History Walk led by David Smith:

This linear 3 mile walk starts at the Five Rise Cafe walking to 7 Arches viaduct looking into the features and history of this historic part of the canal returning to the market square.

Meet David at Five Rise Cafe at 10am.

3 Sir Fred Hoyle Walk led by Ronda Christensen:

This 6 mile walk starts in Bingley town centre and follows the canal and river and rises via the Coach Road and Milner Field to Primrose Lane. We see the house that was Sir Fred Hoyle's birthplace and return to Bingley via Gilstead Moor and Three and Five Rise Locks.

Meet Ronda at Bingley Arts Centre at 2pm.

4 Beckfoot & Cottingley Walk led by Sue Dennis & Arthur Baxter:

Join Sue and Arthur for a 5 mile circular walk round Beckfoot and Cottingley, crossing the golf course, taking in Beckfoot Bridge and parts of Cottingley village.

Meet Sue & Arthur at the Arts Centre at 11am.
